

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

Pakistan Association of Medical and Dental Institutions (PAMI) is organizing the 2nd International Medical Conference (IMC) to explore the revolutionary potential of artificial intelligence in healthcare education. IMC invites researchers, doctors, dentists, allied health professionals and students to submit research abstracts to present at the conference. Guidelines for abstract submission are as follows:

1) Authors:

- Abstracts may have multiple authors.
- The abstract submitter is listed as the first author and presenting author. If the first author is unable to present, another author on the study may present in their place.

2) Abstracts:

In order to be eligible for submission, all abstracts must fulfil the following criteria:

- Must be no longer than 300 words.
- Must be a completed research study. Research proposals or projects that are still in progress will not be considered for presentation.
- Unpublished research is preferred to research projects that have already been published in a journal.
- Must be related to the theme of the conference.

All abstracts must have the following structure:

- Title: Abstract titles should be relevant to the content of the abstract.
- Introduction and Objectives: The introduction should provide context to your reader, an introduction to your topic and its importance, and your study objective, question, or hypothesis, whichever is appropriate.
- The objectives for the research should be clear.
- Materials and Methods: The methodology used in the research must be briefly outlined in the abstract, and any limitations in the methodology should be addressed.
- Results: A summary of the most important results must be included. Key findings should be clear, concise, and explicit.
- Conclusion should clearly communicate the take-home message from the study and it should relate to the study objective(s).

3) Supplementary Materials:

- The abstract may include supplementary materials such as graphs, figures, charts, images etc.
- If the research is studying patient data, the supplements must **not** include any patient identifiers which could violate their privacy (e.g. patient name, patient picture, medical record number etc.)

Note:

- **Only approved abstracts will be scheduled for presentation and publication.**
- **Submitting an abstract does not register you for the conference.**
- **You must register for the conference to be able to submit your abstract. See registration for more details.**
- **Plagiarism in any form is unacceptable. If an abstract is found to be using plagiarized data or research, it will be immediately disqualified. All data taken from another source should be clearly cited.**
